

ORDINANCE NO. 1803

AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, AMENDING PARAGRAPH 14-101 OF CHAPTER XIV. TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "2024 STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 50th EDITION"; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1793, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Paragraph 14-101 of the Code of the City of Wamego, Kansas, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"14-101 INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Wamego, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the '2024 Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 51st Edition', prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped 'Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1803', with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change, with a copy of this Ordinance attached, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient."

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the City's official paper, The Times, Pottawatomie County.
