

ORDINANCE NO. 1804

AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, AMENDING PARAGRAPH 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "2024 UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 40th EDITION" AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1794, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAMEGO, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Paragraph 11-101 of the Code of the City of Wamego, Kansas, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"11-101 INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE BY REFERENCE. (a) There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Wamego, Kansas, that certain code known as the '2024 Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, 40th Edition' prepared and published by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped 'Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1804', and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 1804 and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the City's official paper, The Times, Pottawatomie County.
