FRIENDLY REMINDER: UPDATES TO THE BURN SITE!

Remember as the weather warms up and yard work begins- there have been changes to the Leaf, Limb, and Grass Burn Site! The site is now reserved for Wamego residents and property owners only, so commercial arborists and landscapers will need to use the Pottawatomie County Landfill for organic waste disposal.

THINKING ABOUT PLANTING A TREE?

With Arbor Day and Earth Day around the corner, it's a great time to plant trees! Just a reminder—per Ordinance 1810, trees cannot be planted in the city right-of-way. Be sure to check Chapter 13, Article 3 of the City Codes for guidelines and review Ordinance 1810 for the latest updates. Happy planting!

CEMETERY POLICIES

Spring is just around the corner so here is a reminder of our Wamego City Cemetery policies. First, artificial flowers not in a pre-approved floral display container (as specified in the Wamego City Cemetery Regulations) may be placed adjacent to grave monuments only from October 1st to April 1st. Also, lot owners are prohibited from placing items on graves such as toys, glass, shepherd hooks, chinaware, or other commemorative articles of any kind year-round, with the exception that memorial markers from the armed services or nationally recognized clubs are permitted. Prohibited articles are subject to removal and disposal by the City crews without notice. Finally, reminders about conduct in the Cemetery: don't pick flowers or damage any other plants or remove items not belonging to you, and in keeping with the nature of the Cemetery, no dogs, alcohol, or firearms are allowed (except firearms permitted for military funerals).

REMINDER: GET YOUR BACKFLOW PREVENTERS TESTED ANNUALLY!



If your project requires **excavation**, mark your dig site, then call 1-800-DIG SAFE or simply 811, to ensure that all owners of underground utilities have a chance to mark their utility lines at the site. This service is free of charge.
